Neges gan Gadeirydd y Llywodraethwyr

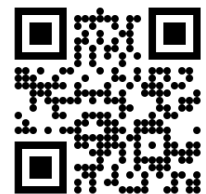

Good news!

It's great to announce that Ysgol Bro Idris has now been removed from Estyn's special measures. Here is an extract of a letter received from Estyn last week: Here is a summary of the main discussion points:

- The school has ensured that education has continued throughout the pandemic, which has enabled secondary age pupils to practise their literacy and numeracy skills across the curriculum.
- Planning for skills provision is more co-ordinated than at the time of the inspection. There is better progression in provision from key stage 2 to key stage 3.
- The school and the authority's monitoring processes have found that teachers, in general, use different strategies and provide a more suitable challenge for pupils.
- Despite the lockdown periods, leaders have continued with self-evaluation processes and use the findings appropriately to plan improvement. Stability in the school's leadership has ensured that they are developing to lead their areas confidently.

Outcome of the review

Ysgol Bro Idris School is judged to have made appropriate progress in respect of the key issues for action, and in developing the capacity to continue to bring about improvements. We will now remove the school from the list of schools requiring Estyn review. There will be no further monitoring activity in relation to this inspection.

Message from the Chair of Governors

It was good to receive confirmation from Estyn this week that Ysgol Bro Idris has implemented improvement recommendations successfully, and we have now been released from performance measurements put in place in December 2019 following their inspection. This is excellent news and a reflection of the hard work and the devotion of all staff, I wish to give everybody a special thanks for this. We should remember that the progress has been accomplished during a very challenging period as a result of Covid, where the provision of learning had to be adjusted, overnight at times! So, congratulations to all staff and pupils at the school.
