On the 19th of October, a group of ten pupils went to the AMRC Cymru site, Broughton for a STEM career fair. The purpose of the trip was to open the pupils' eyes to the possible careers that can be found in North Wales. The pupils really enjoyed the experience with some considering pursuing a career in engineering and others in the medical sciences. At the fair, there was an opportunity to code a robot, troubleshoot a fire alarm system, see new hydrogen-powered technology and solve problems using VR. One of the general points was that almost all businesses offer apprenticeship opportunities. As a result, the young people will receive a salary while learning their trade and receive a degree at the end of the scheme.

Mental Health Day

On the 10th of October it was World Mental Health Awareness day. Anwen and Glesni, the School Nurses and Dion and Delyth, Gwynedd Youth Service came to play games with the pupils.
